

7.3.3. How to know the impact factor of a journal and its quartile?

The impact factor for journals is found in a database in [PoliBuscador](#), known as [Journal Citation Reports \(JCR\)](#).

To access via PoliBuscador, type in the *Journal Citation Report* search box and click on the *Online access* link.

Once inside the database, search the title of the journal to see its impact factor and its position in the quartiles.
